The flawless bodywork is complemented by immaculate Burgundy Leather upholstery and Walnut trim. Fitted with the obligatory cocktail tables this is 1964 Rolls Royce luxury motoring at its best.

The Silver Cloud III was the last of the traditional coachbuilt cars with a separate massive chassis.

Only an examination of this car will show its stunning qualities. Mere words are not enough.

When used as a Bridal car it can be backed up by the Daimler Landalette, the Silver Cloud II or the Bentley S2.

The Silver Cloud III has itself been used as a backup car for others in our collection and is naturally run as a sole car where only a single car is required.

Powered by a 6 ¼ litre High Compression engine this car has the wheels for short distance luxury travel or longer distance cruising.
